

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

"OBJECTIVE SPORT !"

ARTICLE 1 – About Alliance Française

Alliance Française is a nonprofit organization with an endowment of 35 600 000 euros.

It is registered at SIREN under the following number: SIRET 500 110 788 00014

Its siege is located in France at 101 Boulevard Raspail – 75006 Paris.

Alliance Française organizes a photographic contest from March 2016 to May 16th 2016, free of charges.

This contest is called “Objective Sport!”.

The following articles describe the rules, terms and conditions of this contest.

ARTICLE 2 – Conditions of participations

The participation is free.

The contest is about photography around the theme of “Objective Sport!”.

The candidates are asked, in their opinion, to show photos that portrays best a sport activity in their country. The photos can show essential values & discipline of the chosen sport like: tolerance, openness, social inclusion, team work etc.

The candidates must have reached the legal majority age in their country to participate.

The candidates also have to agree completely to the present rules. Any violation will revoke their participation.

ARTICLE 3 – REGISTRATION AND PROCEDURE OF THE CONTEST

The contest will proceed in three steps:

Locally: The first step of the contest will be handled by each Alliance Française and will take place from 10th of March to 10 May 2016. The participating Alliance Française will have to make its own selection and choose its own jury.

Each Alliance Française will have to name its winner and send two pictures.

These pictures will then be studied by a jury in Paris.

The winner will win a one week trip to Paris.

The two pictures will be sent by the Alliance Française to [Fondation Alliance Française Paris](#) with application called “We transfer” (download available and free). The transfer will have to specify the name of the Alliance, of the photographer and the two pictures’s title.

Every incomplete or wrong application will be rejected without causing the liability of the Fondation.

Global : This step is taken care by the Fondation Alliance française, in charge of selecting 40 pictures with its jury for an exhibition which can also be hosted by the Alliance française overseas.

Final selection: Designation of the final winner by the Fondation’s jury.

1/ Submission:

Only the pictures sent to [Fondation Alliance Française Paris](#) before May 10th 2016 will be considered for the contest.

2/ Results

The results will be communicated to the participating Alliance française and will be published on the website: www.fondation-alliancefr.org on the 30th of May 2016.

ARTICLE 4 – Candidates

This contest is open to every person who has reached the legal age of majority in its home country. A candidate can't be a professional photographer known by his photos and living exclusively on the revenue of his photos sales.

Every person willing to register must contact the Alliance Française. Candidates are allowed to send two pictures only. They must guarantee that the pictures they send are their own, original, new and that they are the only owners of their work. To this end, participants are

Responsible for securing authorization from any third person that may have directly or indirectly

Participated in the production of the work, and/or who estimates that he/she has any kind of claim to it.

Participants will be responsible for all financial damages resulting from those claims.

Participants surrender all licensing rights for the presented work to the Foundation Alliance française for the duration of the contest.

In general, participants will be responsible for any legal recourse, legal action or claim that a third

Person could bring forth against the Foundation Alliance française, in relation with the rights transferred

Here or generally in relation with any guaranty or commitment provided in the present agreement.

The Foundation Alliance française reserves the right to proceed to any verification in order to enforce the present article.

In relation with the content of the photography, here is some basic advice:

- Have the agreement of every person photographed;
- Remember that photographs of buildings (new or historical) are subject to ownership rights;
- Do not reproduce urban landscape that can be affected by third party rights;
- Do not show designed objects (clothing, furniture, objects) with a brand or signature;
- Any representation of the consumption of a brand of tobacco or alcohol is forbidden

ARTICLE 5 – Designation of the winners

The jury named by the Fondation Alliance française will be composed of professionals of photography and culture and is asked to choose one winner and nineteen finalists among the candidates.

The Fondation guarantees impartiality, good faith and fairness of the jury.

The jury is allowed to rule out every picture artistically inadequate.

The jury is free to organize itself as it will. There is no appeal against its decision.

The jury will base its decision with the following criteria:

- Coherence
- Relevance
- Harmony between the two pictures
- Quality of the pictures (framing, light, esthetics, originality)

Technical specifications:

Every participant must provide a computer file, if possible a TIFF file but it can also be a JPEG file, with a 300 DPI resolution (4000 pixels), for each of his two photographs.

The following information must also be sent together with each participant's two photographs:

- The reference for the camera used
- If it is possible: the aperture and the shutter speed to make the photographs
- If a roll of film is used: roll of film references: The winner and the finalists will allow the Fondation Alliance française, free of charge, to reproduce and distribute the content of their photographs for the general exposition, to promote and advertise their work on any media known or still unknown today, in the entire world and for a 24 months duration beginning May 10th 2016.

The winner and the finalists will allow the Fondation Alliance française, free of charge, to take pictures and to make visual and/or audio recordings of their participation to the exposition, and to distribute them live or pre-recorded, in their entirety or in pieces, on any media known or still unknown today, in the entire world and for a 24 months duration beginning the day the jury announces the results.

ARTICLE 6 – Prizes

A selection of the work from the finalists and the winner of the 1st prize will be chosen by the jury of the Fondation Alliance française, and exposed in a Parisian art gallery chosen by the Fondation Alliance française and/or in the Fondation Alliance française own gallery.

The pictures will also be published in a specialized magazine.

The first laureate will also win a one week trip to Paris: Transportation (round trip tickets, economy class), stay (FIAP or equivalent category) and a sum of 40 euros per day will be provided by the Fondation Alliance française to the winner.

The prize does not include:

- Any additional charge or fee that might be related to the enjoyment of their prize by the winners: those expenses will be taken care of by the winners themselves.
- Personal spending for the winners (for example transportation inside of France) the winner and the finalists will not receive any payment for their participation in this contest other than the prizes mentioned above.

Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable.

The winner and the finalists will be informed by e-mail and/or by phone by the Alliance française in their own countries.

ARTICLE 7 – Publication of the results

The identity of the winner and the finalists will be published under aliases (pseudonym) given by the candidates and eventually under their real name and can be the objects of publications on the websites of the Fondation Alliance française and the Alliance française overseas.

ARTICLE 8 – Responsibility

Internet is not a secured network. The Fondation can't be held responsible in case of malfunction of the internet network, including caused by external felonies.

Furthermore, the Fondation is also not responsible if there is any trouble in the delivery. Every false declaration or felony will lead to the disqualification of the candidate.

In a case of a casus fortuitus the Fondation keeps the right to amend these regulations, to postpone or cancel the contest. It will not be liable because of any of these modifications.

ARTICLE 9 – Regulation

Participating to this contest means an agreement with the present regulation including the next modifications. The regulation can be consulted on the Fondation’s website www.fondation-alliancefr.org and a copy will be sent by email to every candidate who’s requesting it to this address: concoursphoto@fondation-alliancefr.org until the end of the contest.

Article 10 – Electronical data and liberties

According to the law “Informatique et Libertés” of the January 6th 1978, modified by the law of August 6th 2004, the user has a right of access a right information and a right modification or opposition about any data published or compiled about him. He can oppose to the publication of any information of his. Article 11 – Dispute

This contest is under French legislation for its proceeding in France. Each Alliance française is responsible of its own regulation inspired by this one.
